DON JONGEWAARD

Don Marion Jongewaard, son of Joy and Marion Jongewaard, was born at Hurley, South Dakota, on June 6, 1933. He grew to manhood in Hurley and attended the Hurley Public Schools, graduating from high school in 1951. The following fall he enrolled in the University of South Dakota at Vermillion. Always a star basketball player in the Hurley school, he developed into a college player of exceptional ability. During his senior year in 1956, he established a new North Central scoring mark and at the end of the season he was selected as all-conference center because of his high point average throughout the season.

He was united in marriage to Miss Marilyn Miller of Sioux Falls on November 28, 1956, at Dakota City, Nebraska. She was also a student at the University and at present is teaching school in Hurley where they have been making their home.

Don was presently employed by his father as a school bus driver and as a car salesman for Meisenholder Motor Company of Vermillion while completing his course at the University.

Because of his generous and friendly disposition, Don was widely known throughout this section of South Dakota. He loved the outdoors and was on his way to the Black Hills on a hunting trip when he met his untimely death in a car accident Friday evening, November 1, at 10:15 p.m.

He is survived by his wife, Marilyn, and his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Marion Jongewaard of Hurley, a large number of aunts, uncles and cousins and a host of friends and acquaintances.
