FUNERAL SERVICES HELD JULY 31st FOR MRS. PETER LUND

Funeral services for Mrs. Peter Lund were held on Wednesday, July 31, at 1:00 P.M., at Bethany Lutheran Church in Viborg. Rev. Gerhard Lingen officiated. Organist was Mrs. Helen Holm and soloist was Rhoda Gaddis who sang "Beautiful Isle of Somewhere" and "In The Garden". Pallbearers were Layne Jorgensen, Pete Smith, Russell Georgeson, Lawrence Hansen, Gene Georgeson and Fred Knudsen. Burial was to be in Wisconsin Memorial Park near Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Edna Georgeson Lund, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. George Georgeson, was born in Rushford, Winnebago County, Wisconsin, on March 11, 1885.

After being ill for some time she quietly passed away July 28, 1963, at the age of 78 years, 4 months and 17 days.

While an infant she with her parents and family moved to the Viborg vicinity in Turner County, and it was here she spent her childhood and early adult years.

On April 6, 1910, she was united in marriage to Juel Fastrup of Yankton County at Yankton and to this union two children were born, Faye, Mrs. Glen Hoff, and Virgil.

During their early married life they lived on a farm near Irene, where they resided until the spring of 1917. They then bought and established a home in Hutchinson County near Freeman, S. Dak., where they resided until about March, 1934.

In the winter of 1918-19, Mr. Fastrup became afflicted with multiple sclerosis which grew progressively worse until he became a helpless invalid in a wheelchair, and the family discontinued farming and moved to Freeman.

During these years Mrs. Fastrup devoted her entire time to her husband and family, being his constant companion and nurse and one can truly say her hands have been hands of unselfish service for others.

About in October, 1944, they moved to Milwaukee, Wis., where they made their home with their daughter, Faye, and her husband for several years until Mr. Fastrup passed away in October 1946, and he was laid to rest in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Mrs. Fastrup, after nursing her husband for over twenty-five years, continued her service in helping the sick by doing practical nursing after his passing.

On March 20, 1955, she was united in marriage to Peter Lund of Viborg and they have made their home in Viborg.

Mrs. Lund was an active and faithful member of the Lutheran church in the communities where she has lived.

She leaves to mourn her passing, her husband, Peter Lund, daughter Faye and husband, Mr. and Mrs. Glen Hof, and son Virgil and wife of Vancouver, Wash., 4 grandchildren, one brother, T. F. Georgeson and wife, three sisters-in-law, Mrs. Vera Jacobson, Mrs. Kathryn Georgeson, and sister-in-law and husband, Mr. and Mrs. Lawrence Peterson, as well as a large number of nieces, nephews, many other relatives and friends.
