Funeral Services Held For Chris P. Larsen

Funeral services for Chris P. Larsen were held from the Wass Chapel at Centerville on Wednesday, Feb. 3. Rev. Hal Hawkins officiated. Chris P. Larsen was born Aug. 28, 1883, in Denmark, and passed away Jan. 30, 1960 at the Pioneer Memorial Hospital in Viborg, S. D. He had attained the age of 76 years, 5 months and 2 days.

In 1905 he immigrated to America and settled in South Dakota. For a short time he worked in the Viborg and Hooker area and later became engaged in commercial trucking and farming near Viborg. He remained on the farm until 1956 when he retired and moved to Centerville. On October 3, 1947, he was married to Margaret Morrison.

Mr. Larsen is survived by three children by a previous marriage: Mrs. Signa Johnson of Sioux Falls, Mr. Richard Larsen of Viborg, and Mrs. Palma Sanborn of Hurley. He is also survived by six grandchildren, two great-grandchildren, one brother, Magnus Larsen of Viborg, and two sisters, Mrs. Paul Larsen of Viborg and Mrs. Marie Swendsen of Denmark, and other relatives and good friends who will mourn his passing.
