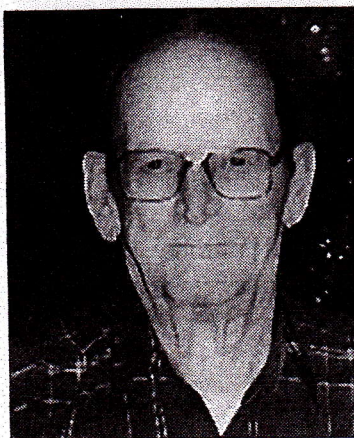

Noble Jensen was born March 12, 1915 at Viborg. His parents were Jim A. and Emma (Jensen) Jensen.

Noble attended School District 43 county school. On June 23, 1940 he married Melissa Nielsen at Viborg. They farmed in the Viborg area. He served on the Swan Lake Township board, drove the township maintainer, served several years on the Turner county Soil conservation board, served on the council for his church and drove the school bus for Hurley and Viborg schools. He was a member of the Danish Dancers. Noble enjoyed square dancing, being outdoors on the farm and spending time with his grandchildren.

Noble passed away on October 4, 2001 at Avera Sacred Heart Hospital in Yankton. He had attained the age of 86.

He was preceded in death by his parents; one brother Grant Jensen; five sisters Luella Thompson, Naomi Peterson, Engrecia Sorenson, Vivian Browne and Twila Lubke.
