Obituary.

DIED—at her home, two miles east of Viborg, Mrs. Carrie Marie Christensen, on Wednesday, June 21, 1899, from heart failure.

Mrs. Christensen was born in Syndre, Binslev, Vendsyssel, Denmark, on November 1, 1835. She was married to Chris Christensen Aug. 1, 1859. They emigrated to America in July, 1868, and located at Racine, Wisconsin. In 1877 they removed to Dakota territory, where they have resided ever since. She was the mother of eight children, two of which

died in Denmark. The remaining ones, Mrs. Nicholas Nelson, N. C. Andrews, John Christenson, Tillie Christenson, Anton Christenson and Mrs. Mary Frederickson, who have grown to man and womanhood right here in Turner county, are left to bereave the death of a good and christian mother.

Mrs. Christenson was an active worker in the Baptist church and will be missed amongst the members of that congregation, for those that knew her could but love and respect her.

The funeral services will be held at the residence Friday forenoon, thence to the Baptist church for the funeral sermon, and the remains will be taken to the Baptist cemetery for interment.
