Rites Held For Aksel J. Hansen

Aksel J. Hansen, 70 years of age, of 1201 South 9th Street, Beatrice, NE, died at the Beatrice Community Hospital on Sunday morning, May 1, 1988. He was born September 7, 1917 in Plentywood, Montana and moved to Beatrice from Viborg, South Dakota in December of 1987. He was a former resident of Rapid City, South Dakota, Minneapolis, Minnesota, lived in Kearney, Nebraska for 7 years at which time he was employed by the Nash Finch Company as a General Merchandise Manager for 17 years before his retirement. He was a member of the Our Savior's Lutheran Church of Viborg, South Dakota. He was a past member of the Elks Club and the Masonic Lodge. He was the past president of the Nebraska Numismatic Association.
