**PIONEER MOTHER IS
LAID TO REST HERE**

**Mrs. Soren Andersen Passed
On At Her Home Sun-
day**

Mrs. Soren Andersen, died at her farm home northeast of Viborg Sunday morning at the age of 77. Mrs. Andersen was one of the real pioneers of this section of the country, having resided where she passed away for 47 years. The deceased was preceded in death by two daughters, Mayme and Florence, and survived by her husband and two sons, Peder A. and Henry M., both of this community, also nine grand-children.

Jorgine Pedersen was born on the Island of Bornholm, Denmark, on September 23rd, 1854 and immigrated to America in the spring of 1880, locating at Chicago, Illinois.

On March 26th, 1884 she married Soren Andersen and they moved to Turner county, South Dakota, and homesteaded on the farm where they now reside.

Mrs. Andersen was a life long member of the Lutheran church, a faithful christian, was always willing and ready to lend a helping hand or extend words of comfort to her neighbors and friends. During her life she has cared for and made a home for two motherless children.

Burial was made from the South Lutheran church today (Wednesday).
