FUNERAL SERVICES HELD HERE MONDAY FOR ADOLPH MORCK

Funeral services for Adolph Morck were held on Monday, March 10, 1975, from Our Savior's Lutheran Church, Viborg, with Pastor Donald G. Love officiating. Organist was Mrs. James Oakland, and soloist was Vernon Andersen who sang "Beyond the Sunset" and "Our Father Has Light In His Window". Pallbearers were: Leslie Peterson, Fred Knudsen, Bill Wieland, Tony Starcke, Dick Fikse and Leonard C. Sorensen. Interment was in Spring Valley Baptist Cemetery.

A Prayer Service was held at the Viborg Funeral Home on Sunday evening, March 9th.

Adolph Morck was born Sept. 26 1902, in Lokken, Denmark. He passed away at the Pioneer Memorial Hospital March 7, 1975 at the age of 72 years, 5 months and 11 days.

He had been a resident of the Pioneer Memorial Nursing Home for the last 3½ years.

Adolph immigrated to the United States in 1923. In September of 1928, he was united in marriage to Annie Anderson. Adolph and Annie lived in the Viborg community all of their married lives except for eight years spent in Iowa.

Adolph served the City of Viborg for many years, working with the water department, and also the police department.

Annie and Adolph were members of Our Savior's Lutheran Church congregation.

He is survived by his wife, Annie; three sons: Reuben of Viborg, South Dakota, Robert of California, and Roger of Sioux Falls, South Dakota; six grandchildren; one great-grandchild; three sisters in Denmark; and many nieces and nephews and other relatives and friends.
