ANTON PAULSEN DIED AT YANKTON

Anton Paulsen, age 70, formerly of Viborg, passed away at the Sacred Heart hospital at Yankton last Tuesday night. He leaves his widow and one daughter, Mrs. Aage Ibsen of Yankton.

Funeral services will be held at the Bethany Lutheran church in Viborg on Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Obituary next week.

Anton Paulsen

Anton Paulsen was born in Sæbro Sogn near Aarhus, Denmark December 2nd, 1869. Was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran church in Denmark. In the spring of 1890 he left his native country and came to Lstant, Illinois, U. S. He was united in marriage to Bertha Johanne Hulbeg on December 22, 1901. To this union was born two children, one boy, Hans Peter, who died in infancy, and Lenore Sophie, now Mrs. Aage Ibsen, Yankton, S. Dak. In the year of 1912 he came with his family to Viborg, S. Dak., where they lived until 1931 when they moved to Yankton, S. D. Anton Paulsen passed away at the Sacred Heart hospital, Yankton on July 23rd, 1940 being at the time of his death, 70 years, 7 months and 21 days old. He leaves to mourn, his wife and one daughter and 3 grandchildren, all of Yankton. Also 6 brothers, Carl of Hurley; Otto of Hooker; 3 brothers and one sister in Illinois; 1 brother in Ohio; and one sister in Denmark. He was buried on Friday, July 26th, in Viborg. The funeral was in charge of the Burke funeral directors, Yankton. Services were held in their parlors and in the Bethany Lutheran church at Viborg, Rev. H. Stallknecht officiating. Interment was in the Bethany cemetery.
