LAST RITES HELD FRIDAY, MAY 27, FOR CHARLEY HANSEN

Funeral services for Charley Hansen were held on Friday afternoon, May 27th, from Our Savior's Lutheran Church. Rev. Paul Petersen officiated. Mrs. L. J. Rasmussen was organist and accompanied Mrs. Kermit Holm who sang two solos. Pallbearers were Arlo Andersen, Burnell Christensen, Burdell Christensen, Thomas Nooney, Gerald Morrison and Herbert Peterson. Burial was in Rosehill Cemetery with military honors.

Charley Hansen was born in Hurley, S. Dak., to the late Jens C. and Christena Hansen on Dec. 24, 1918.

He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran Church at Viborg, S. Dak. In February of 1942, he answered his country's call and while fighting in the Battle of Cassino in Italy, he lost his mother in Viborg.

After returning from the service, he was associated with his father and brother at Hansen's Produce.

In the fall of 1962, it became apparent that Charley was suffering from an illness from which he passed away on Tuesday, May 24, 1966, at the Veteran's Hospital in Sioux Falls, S. Dak.

He was preceded in death by his father and mother.

He is survived by his brother, John Hansen of Irene, S. Dak., two sisters, Mrs. Roy W. Hansen (Anna) of Parker, S. Dak., and Mrs. Norman Ostroot (Carolina) of Viborg, S. Dak.; five nieces: Carol Ann, Glennys, Jean, Joan and Anita; and two nephews: Vaughan and Johnny.
