FUNERAL SERVICES HELD HERE TUESDAY FOR JOHN E. MILLER

Funeral services for John E. Miller were held from the First Baptist Church of Viborg on Tuesday, Sept. 9, at 2:00 p.m., with the Rev. Kenneth L. Peterson, pastor, officiating. John Ervin Miller was born to Nels and Elise Miller on November 30, 1895, in Turner County, South Dakota, and passed away on Sept. 6, 1969, at the Veterans Hospital, Minneapolis, Minn., at the age of 73 years, 9 months and 7 days.

He served in the U. S. Navy in World War I.

He was united in marriage to Loretta I. Monk on February 22, 1923, in Minnesota and to this union three sons and one daughter were born. He and his wife operated a cafe in Minnesota.

Upon his return to Viborg he became a rural mail carrier out of Viborg until his retirement in 1960.

He was a member of the American Legion of Viborg, the Danish Brotherhood Society, and the Odd Fellows Lodge.

He had a great love for his family, his country, and his fellow men.

He was preceded in death by his wife, a son, Robert, and an infant daughter.

He is survived by two sons, Harry (Buster) of Estherville, Ia., and John (Pat) of Sioux Falls, S. Dak.; eight grandchildren; one brother, Sam, and many neices and nephews.
