LEAVES SIX CHILD- REN TO MOURN LOSS

Funeral Services From Elin
Lutheran Church
Monday

On Friday morning, May 7th, 1926, Frank Anderson passed away at his home west of Viborg, after having been a patient sufferer from paralysis for the past six years. The last three weeks he was confined to his bed and passed away very peacefully early Friday morning.

Mr. Anderson was born in Sweden August 7th, 1854, and came to America when he was a young man. He was united in marriage in Chicago to Miss Anna Larson, who preceded him in death July 19th, 1923.

About forty-one years ago he came to South Dakota, where he has resided until the time of his death.

Mr. Anderson leaves to mourn his death, six children: four sons—Arthur, Fred and Ted of Viborg, and Harry, of Canada; two daughters—Mrs. Mat Johnson and Mrs. Leus Simonson.

Funeral services were held on Monday from the home and the Elin Lutheran church, Rev. Odland of Yankton officiating, assisted by Rev. H. M. Andersen, of Viborg. The remains were laid to rest in the Carl-
