Funeral Held For Howard Reisner, 75

Howard Reisner, age 75, of Yankton, died Friday, January 23, at Sacred Heart Hospital at Yankton. Funeral service was held on Monday, January 26, at 1:30 p.m. at Calvary Lutheran Church at Irene, with burial in Hillcrest Cemetery at Irene.

Howard was born on July 24, 1911, at Parker, South Dakota, to Theodore and Nettie Reisner. His family moved to Minnesota when he was 1-1/2 years old to homestead. When he was 18 years old they moved to a farm near Marion.

He married Erma Jensen on August 22, 1934 at Yankton. To this union two sons and three daughters were born. They lived at Viborg until July 1, 1955, when they moved to Yankton. Howard was a mechanic at Viborg and later at Yankton. He later worked as a carpenter around Yankton and then was employed by Mitchell Aerial Spraying in Yankton until his retirement.

He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran Faith at Spring Valley

Lutheran Church, rural Viborg, and a member of Turkey Valley Lutheran Church at Irene in 1965.

Due to ill health, he resided at the Wakonda Heritage Manor in Wakonda for a month until the time of his death.

Survivors include his wife, Erma; three daughters, Mrs. Edwin (Marjorie) Olson of Irene, Florence Fiedler of Sioux City, Iowa, and Bonnie Olson of Vermillion; two brothers, Fred Reisner of Yankton and Roy Reisner of Lake Elsinor, California; 15 grandchildren and 13 great-grandchildren; three sisters, Mrs. Evan (Eva) Tilley of Seal Beach, California, Alice Jensen of Riverbank, California, and Jeanette Powell of Arkansas.

Howard was preceded in death by his parents, two sons, Leo and Vernon, two brothers and one sister.
