Funeral Held For Fern A. Christensen

Services were held on Monday, February 16, 1987 at the Chancellor Reformed Church in Chancellor, South Dakota for Fern A. Christensen who died February 12, 1987. Rev. Harlan Hayunga officiated at the services. The organist was Denise Ihnen and soloist was Arnold VanHove. She was laid to rest in the Bethania Cemetery in Viborg, South Dakota.

Fern Audrey Christensen was born on a farm near Viborg, South Dakota on May 6, 1928, the daughter of Edward and Anna (Petersen) Christensen. She grew to womanhood in the Hurley area and graduated from Hurley High School.

Fern moved to Sioux Falls where she was employed at Northwestern Bell Telephone Co., for over 30 years. She retired on June 21, 1978 and continued to make her home in Sioux Falls since that time.

She was a member of the First Lutheran Church of Sioux Falls.

Following recent hospitalization, Fern died at McKennan Hospital in Sioux Falls on February 12, 1987, having attained the age of 58 years, nine months and six days.

Surviving are two brothers: Virgil Christensen and his wife, Waneta, of Brookings, and her twin, Darrell Christensen and his wife, Mavis, of Parker; two sisters: Gwen Danielsen and her husband, Ellsworth, of Viborg and Arlene Plucker and her husband, Virgil, of Hurley; her special friend, Marvin Wiese of Sioux Falls; and several nieces and nephews.
