Funeral Services Held Last
Sunday at Elims Luth.
Church

Anna Louise Larson was born in Sweden on December 1st, 1863, and died at her home west of Viborg on Thursday, July 19th, 1923, at 6:30 P. M., being at the time of her death 59 years, 7 months and 19 days of age.

In the year of 1880 they immigrated to this country, and lived in Chicago where she was married on November 25th, 1883, to Frank Anderson. In 1884 Mr. and Mrs. Anderson came to Mayfield township where she resided until her death.

Mrs. Andersen leaves to mourn her death her husband and six children, Arthur, Harry, Mrs. Mat Johnson, Fred, Mrs. Lenus Simonsen, and Theodore, and three grand children. One daughter preceeded her in death.

The funeral was held Sunday, July 22nd, and was conducted by Rev. H. H. Andersen of Viborg, and Rev. Nordsletten of Irene, in Elims church, and the remains were laid to rest in the Carlson cemetery.
