#### EMIL T. LARSON

Funeral services for Emil T. Larson, long time Viborg business man, were held last Saturday afternoon at the First Baptist Church, with Rev. Elmer Lien officiating. Pallbearers were Newell Sorensen, Tosten Williamson, Edgar Dickerson, Arthur Jensen, Keith Keller and Glenn Johnson.

Emil T. Larson, son of James and Hannah Larson, was born on a farm near Beresford on May 10, 1878. When a young man, he came to Viborg to work. On July 19, 1904, he was united in marriage to Nora Morrison, and to this union two children were born, a daughter, Meryl, and a son, Norman. The family lived in Conde, South Dakota, for seven years and then returned to Viborg, where Mr. Larson engaged in business until his retirement in 1950. His health began to fail three years ago, and for the past year he had been a patient at the Viborg Hospital, where he died on Wednesday, Jan. 20th. His wife preceded him in death in 1939.

He is survived by a son, Norman of Denver, Colo., a daughter, Mrs. Meryle Lien of Aberdeen, South Dakota, two sisters, Mrs. Minnie Jorgensen of Irene, and Miss Florence Larson of Denver, Colo.; two brothers, Victor of Yankton, and Ellis of Los Angeles, Calif., and four grandchildren.

Emil Larson was a member of Emounah Lodge, A. F. & A. M., the I. O. O. F., and Sunshine Chapter, O. E. S. He was very interested in Civic affairs and served as clerk of the school district for many years.
