Funeral services were held for May Christopherson on Saturday, July 24, 1982 from Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Viborg with Pastor Olaf Roynesdal officiating. May Jensen was born in How, Denmark May 1, 1892. She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith and was a member of Our Savior's Lutheran Church, Viborg, S. D. In April of 1909 she immigrated to the United States and came to the Viborg area. On February 9, 1913 she was united in marriage to Andrew Christopherson. They lived in the Viborg area most of their married lives. Andrew passed away November 12, 1969.

May entered Pioneer Memorial Nursing Home on January 1, 1970 as the first resident. This was her home for 12½ years, at the time of her death she was the longest-residing resident of the Home. May passed away at the Pioneer Memorial Hospital July 20, 1982. She was 90 yrs. of age.

May was a member of the Danish Sisterhood for many years.

Preceding her in death besides her husband Andrew, were an infant daughter and an infant son, one son Harry, lost in World War II; two grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

Among her survivors are two sons, Earl of Irene, S.D. and Ellwood of Sundance, Wyoming and their wives; one daughter Viola of Yucca Valley, Calif.; thirteen grandchildren; 26 great-grandchildren; one sister in Denmark;

many nieces, nephews, and other relatives and friends.
