Mrs. Nielsen was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran Faith, but for the past twenty years has faithfully attended the Baptist Church.

On Wednesday, August 4th, she became suddenly ill and was taken to the Sioux Valley Hospital where she passed away Sunday, August 8th.

She was a member of O. E. S. and Rebekah Lodges, American Legion Auxiliary, and the What-I-Can Society.
