LAST RITES HELD FOR MARVIN G. JOHNSON

Funeral services for Marvin Johnson were held Friday afternoon, Feb. 28th, from Bethany Lutheran Church. Rev. G. Undem officiated. Music was furnished by Mrs. James Oakland, organist, and Mrs. Kenneth Knudsen, Irene, soloist. Pallbearers were Albert Dangel, Louis Larsen, Hilmen Lier, Peter L. Christensen, Luverne Swensen and Henry Chase. Burial was in Bethany Lutheran Cemetery. Hansen Funeral Home, Irene, was in charge of arrangements.

Marvin G. Johnson, son of Martin and Emma Hendricksen Johnson, was born near Viborg, S. D., in Daneville township, on Sept. 6, 1908. Here he grew to manhood and attended school. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith.

On Sept. 15, 1936, he was united in marriage to Gladys Hansen of Viborg at Sioux Falls, S. Dak. To this union one son, Lowell, was born.

Shortly after their marriage they moved to the farm northwest of Viborg where they have resided ever since.

Mr. Johnson had been in ill health for about two years. On Feb. 6th he entered the Clinic at Rochester for a medical check-up. On Monday, Feb. 24th, he was stricken with a fatal heart attack at Yankton, S. Dak., where he had gone to a livestock sale.

He was a member of the Bethany Lutheran Church, a member of the Moose Lodge at Yankton.

He leaves to mourn his sudden passing, his wife, Gladys; his son, Lowell, both of Viborg, S. D.; one sister, Shirley (Mrs. Leslie Larsen) of Harrisburg, S. D.; three brothers, Wilbert, Murrel, and Donald of Viborg, S. D.; one half-sister, Anna (Mrs. Walter Simpson) of Castana, Iowa; several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his step-mother, one sister, Geneva; and two brothers, Wesley and Glen.
