## Funeral Held For Roy T. Christensen

Roy Tilden Christensen, age 64, of 443 Valley, Dr., Carroll, IA, and formerly of Lake City, IA, died at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll on Jan. 8, following a lingering illness.

Roy was a long-time teacher and had taught math, bookkeeping and typing at Lake City High School from 1960 until 1976. Prior to this he had taught at Ringstead, IA, Clearmont, MN, and one year at Scotland, SD. He has lived in Carroll since 1987.

He was born October 25, 1930, at Viborg, SD, and was married to Bonita Giedd on August 10, 1954, at Owatonna, MN. He was the son of Roy and Tilda Andersen Christensen.

He was a veteran of the Korean War, having served in the infantry from 1952 to 1954.

Roy was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Carroll; The Masonic Lodge of Hurley, SD; The Maurice

Dunn Post of the American Legion of Carroll; The Copestone Chapter #78 R.A.M., Royal and Select Master of Iowa Cryptic Council No. 38 R&SM and Azgad Commandery No. 63, all of which he had served as its leaders. He was a former member of ZaGaZig Shrine Temple in Des Moines, IA. He was a member of Signet Chapter #1 Order of the Eastern Star of Carroll and had served as Chaplain of the Chapter. He was a member of the Iowa Teachers Assoc., and the National Education Assoc.

Surviving are his wife, Bonita of Carroll; a daughter, Sue Sievers and her husband, Rick of Auburn, IA; a daughter, Jane Montgomery and her husband, Roger of Grove City, PA; and 5 grandchildren: Kelly, Justin and Joel Sievers, and Linsey and Katie Montgomery; and an aunt, Dollie Petersen of Viborg. He was preceded in death by his parents.

Funeral service was held Thursday, Jan. 12, at the First Presbyterian Church in Carroll with Pastor John Rozendaal officiating. Organist was Mrs. Sally Patten and soloist Mr. David Bell. Interment was in the Lake City Cemetery.
