NIELS PETER CHRISTIANSEN

Funeral services for Niels Christiansen, who passed away October 15th, were held at the Bethany Lutheran church on Thursday, October 18th. Rev. Holger Berthelsen officiated at the funeral and Rev. Sanaker spoke at the service. A trio, consisting of Marilyn Fletcher, Priscilla Berthelsen and Ardys Dalseg, sang two songs: "Softly and Tenderly" and "Abide With Me". Niels Peter Christiansen, son of Christian and Christine Pedersen, was born in Ugilt, Sindal, Denmark, on April 26th, 1882, and passed away on October 15th, 1951, at the age of 69 years, 5 months and 19 days. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith.

In 1902 he came to America and settled at Irene. He later came to Viborg where he has lived the rest of his life.

On June 30, 1916, he was united in marriage to Jensine Wolhoy. To this union were born four children: Leroy, Marie (Mrs. Elmer Vik), Roger, in the service in New Hampshire, and James.

He leaves to mourn his passing, his loving wife, his children, one grandchild, Karen Vik, six brothers, Miller and Pete of Viborg, Viggo of Irene, Chris of Wakonda, and Alfred and Torvold of Denmark, and five sisters, Mrs. Anne Normand and Dagmar of Denmark, Mrs. Nels Christensen of Viborg, Katherine of Seattle, Wash., and Mrs. James Sanaker of Alcester, also a host of relatives and friends.
