Funeral services for Mrs. G. Martin Nielsen, who passed away Sunday morning, were held at Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Viborg on Wednesday afternoon, July 22. Rev. Harald Ibsen officiated. Pallbearers were Carl Hansen, Victor Hansen, Lawrence Hansen, Harold Hansen, Raymond Hansen and Robert Hansen. Interment was in Rosehill Cemetery with the Viborg Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

Mrs. Anna Kristine Nielsen was born the daughter of Johan and Kristine Hansen on July 29, 1888, in Vadum, Denmark. She passed away in a Sioux Falls hospital on Sunday, July 19, 1959.

She was baptized and confirmed in the Vadum Church in Denmark. At the age of 17 years she emigrated to the United States and for a time worked in Sioux City. In 1913 she was united in marriage to G. Martin Nielsen. They have since then made their home in the Viborg community.

Mrs. Nielsen is survived by her husband, four children—Nanfheldt of Viborg, Melissa (Mrs. Noble Jensen) of Viborg, Wilfert of Viborg, and Norman of Centerville. Also 14 grandchildren, four brothers—Jens Hansen of Viborg, Peter Hansen of Washington, Chris Hansen of Milbank, S.
