LAST RITES HELD FOR SENA MOLLENHOFF FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 9

Funeral services for Mrs. Sena Mollenhoff, 79, who passed away Tuesday, Nov. 6, were held Friday afternoon, Nov. 9, from the Bethany Lutheran Church. Rev. G. E. Undem officiated. Music was furnished by Ray Bak and Mrs. G. E. Undem who sang a duet and were accompanied by Mrs. Leonard Holm. Pallbearers were Chris O. Hansen, Chris Mikkelsen, Raymond Fredericksen, Ellwood Paulsen, Delano Christensen and Wilmar Christensen. Interment was at the Bethania Cemetery.

Mrs. Sena Mollenhoff, daughter of Rasmus and Mariann Erickson, was born on a farm near Viborg, on July 6, 1883.

She passed away 10:25 a.m. on Nov. 6, 1962, at the Sioux Valley Hospital where she had been a patient for seven weeks suffering from a heart ailment.

Sena was a member of Bethany Lutheran Church of Viborg. Baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith, she continued in that faith until her death.

In June of 1920, she was united in marriage with John Mollenhoff.

For a period of years in the thirties, she worked in the Nurses' Home at Sioux Valley Hospital.

She was preceded in death by her parents, four sisters, and two brothers. Remaining to mourn her loss are: one sister, Mrs. Carrie Tone of Sioux Falls; three brothers, Erick Erickson of Viborg, Andrew and David Erickson of Lennox, S. Dak.; many other relatives, and a host of friends.
