OBIUTARY

Nels Christian Larsen was born June 7, 1865, in Tanderup Parish, Denmark. He emigrated to this country in 1884, and settled in Turner county which has since been his home.

On December 4, 1891, he was united in marriage to Karen Christina Pedersen. To this union, eight children were born, four boys and four girls. His wife and the children, with the exception of one, Etena, survive him as does also Mrs. Roy Flyger, the daughter of a former marriage.

The children, Anna, Mrs. Roy Flyger of Parker, S. D., Chris and Harrie of Irene, Peter and Bertha, Mrs. E. E. Bartell of Ronan, Mont., Ida, Mrs. J. O. Hanson of Keene, Texas, Clifford of Hurley, S. D., and Victoria, attending Union college at Lincoln, Nebr., were all present at the funeral with the exception of Mrs. Bartell. He leaves, also, to mourn his sad demise, three brothers in Denmark and one, Andrew, of Tyler, Minn., also two sisters, Mrs. K. C. Madsen of Tyler, Min., and Mrs. C. J. Aalborg of Viborg.

Mr. Larsen had been failing in health during the past winter months, which apparently accounted for his untimely death on the afternoon of Thursday, May 7, 1931.

The funeral was conducted by C. C. Rasmussen at the Danish Lutheran church on Monday afternoon, May 11, 1931. Interment was made in the Rosehill cemetery.
