Niels Christian Nielson passed away at his home near Montrose, at 12 o'clock noon on November the 14th, 1933, at the age of 62 years, one month and 8 days. He was born in Aalborg, Denmark, at the age of eleven he emigrated to South Dakota with his parents, in the neighborhood of Irene, S. D., where he lived with his parents until the age of 23 years, when he left for Taylor, Williamson County, Texas. When he was 25 years of age he united in marriage with Miss Serena Nielson of Taylor, Texas. To this union 13 children were born, twelve of whom are still living. Mr. and Mrs. Nielson after they were first married lived for one year in Taylor, Williamson Co., Texas, then they moved to Austin, Texas, where they resided for 11 years. Then they moved to Irene, S. D., where they lived for 13 years. In 1919 they moved with their family to Montrose, S. D., and have lived here for 14 years.
