OBITUARY, MAR- TIN FREDERICKSON

Fred Martin Frederickson was born in Lund Brejele Patorde, Denmark, Jan. 11th, 1867. He came with his parents to America at the age of three and one half years and settled in Racine, Wis., where they lived a few years, later moving to Yankton S. D., where they lived for a short while, until they moved on their homestead just west of Viborg, where he lived with his folks until he was married to Anna Morrison on April 25th, 1900, then moving to their new home just north of the old home place, where they lived for 15 years, then buying Mrs. Frederickson's birth place, where they lived until his death. To this union three children were born, namely, Erma, Mandal and Iva, who with their mother survive him. He also leaves one sister, Mrs. M. A. Bacon, of Keeline, Wyo., and one brother, N. P. Frederickson, of Viborg, and also his aged father of this city to mourn his death. His mother and brother Myron Frederickson, also two infant brothers, has preceded him to the great beyond.

He united with the Baptist church about 22 years ago and has ever since been a member of the same.

He died August 8th, 1920, after a lingering illness of complication of diseases lasting since October, 1919.

Besides his immediate family he leaves a multitude of relatives and friends to mourn his early death.

The funeral took place from the home and the Baptist church Wednesday, August 11th, and interment was made at the Baptist cemetery. Rev. H. M. Anderson and Rev. C. E. Peters officiating.
