LAST RITES HELD FOR LIZZIE MORGENSEN

Funeral services for Mrs. Lizzie Morgensen were held at Bethany Lutheran Church on Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Pastor G. E. Undem officiated. Mrs. Delano Christensen sang two solos, and Mrs. Leonard Holm presided at the organ. Pallbearers were six nephews: Hoyer Anderson, Paul Anderson, Le Roy Hanson, Newell Sorensen, Leonard Paulsen and Roy Sorensen. Interment was in the Hansen Cemetery.

Lizzie Marie Anderson was born October 10, 1874, in Denmark, the daughter of Paul and Kristine Anderson, and was baptized the same year in the Lutheran faith.

In May of 1879 at the age of 4, she arrived in Turner County with her parents and two small brothers. Here she lived until the time of her death.

She was united in marriage to Peter Sorensen on June 25, 1895, and settled on a farm near Irene, S. Dak. To this union two children were born, Nels and Christine, and they also reared a foster daughter, Hilda, from early childhood.

Lizzie and her husband, Peter, retired in 1926 and made their home in Viborg where Mr. Sorensen passed away Nov. 22, 1936.

On Sept. 7, 1944, Lizzie was united in marriage to Alfred Morgensen, who preceded her in death Sept. 12, 1957.

Mrs. Morgensen passed away at the Pioneer Memorial Hospital in Viborg on May 10, 1962, after a lingering illness, at the age of 87 years, 7 months.

She is survived by her son, Nels C. Sorensen, Sioux Falls, S. Dak., and daughters, Christine, Mrs. Dewey Peterson, Yankton, S. Dak., and Hilda, Mrs. Roy Mikkelsen, Irene, S. Dak., and two stepchildren, Mrs. Alfred Petersen, Centerville, S. Dak., and John Morgensen, Albert Lea, Minn. She is also survived by 7 grandchildren, 14 great-grandchildren, and one great-great-grandchild.

She was a devoted Christian mother and grandmother.
