OBITUARY

Laurits Hoyer Anderson was born in Vensyssel, Denmark, the 28th day of May 1836, whereby he reached the ripe old age of 82 years, 3 months and 15 days.

He emigrated to and arrived at Chicago in 1870 but at the confusion of the great Chicago fire in 1871 he moved to Plano, Ill. in 1875, where he resided until 1883, when he moved to South Dakota and settled down near Swan Lake, Turner Co., in which immediate vicinity he has lived ever since. His death came sudden, was only sick a few days.

In 1866 he was united by marriage to Maren Larsen, who yet survives him. They were blessed with six children, of which two died in infancy. The others are: Mrs. Charles Olsen, Chicago, Ill.; Mrs. L. C. Jensen, Cedar Rapids, Iowa, Mrs. C. J. Glood, Viborg and Mr. Andrew J. Andersen, of Freeman, S. D.

The survivors all realize that they by his death have lost the close touch of a kind and always joyful husband and father, only to meet him again at the beautiful shores beyond the death and the grave.

The funeral took place from the home and from the Methodist Episcopal church Monday afternoon.

A large host of relatives and friends had met to say the last farewell. Rev. Folkestad officiated.
