CHRIS E. CARLSON

Funeral services for Chris E. Carlson, 47, of 603 First St. East, who died Monday morning in a Williston hospital, were held at 10:00 A. M. on Friday at the Sletten - Erdahl Chapel. The Rev. David Egeland and Major James Elcombe officiated. Burial was in Riverview Cemetery.

Surviving are his widow, Mildred, two daughters, Charleen and Helen both at home; one brother, Carl Carlson of Sac City, Ia., and one sister, Mrs. Chris Lonning of Hurley, S. Dak. He was preceded in death by his parents, one sister and two brothers.

Mr. Carlson was born Dec. 10, 1915, at Viborg, S. Dak., where he was reared and educated and later employed. He married Mildred Berg of Zohl, N. Dak., on Aug. 21, 1944, at Sidney, Mont. In 1946 they moved to Williston, N. Dak. He resided in Williston since and was employed by the G. N. Railroad on the section crew since December of 1946.
