Last Rites Held Here For Roy Christensen

Funeral services for Roy Christensen were held Thursday afternoon, Feb. 4, 1965, at the Bethany Lutheran Church in Viborg with Rev. G. E. Undem officiating. Numbers were sung by Mrs. Burton Benson. Interment was made in the Hurley Cemetery. Short military rites were held at the graveside.

He served in the Military Police at Camp Dodge, Iowa, during World War I.
