Annie A. Morck was born March 27, 1905 on the family homestead in Salem Township, Turner County. Her parents were Martin and Mary (Hansen) Andersen.

She graduated from Viborg High School in 1925. She worked as an operator for the telephone company. She married Adolph Morck on September 1, 1928. She lived her entire life in Viborg with the exception of living in Harlan, IA for eight years with her husband and family. She had a daycare in her home. She also cleaned the church, and worked for the local cafe and the school lunch program. Adolph passed away in 1975. She was a Sunday School teacher for 20 years at Our Saviors Lutheran Church. She moved into Pioneer Memorial Nursing Home in June 1987. In later years, she began writing for the local newspaper in a column she entitled the "Good Old Days". She enjoyed crocheting, running errands and looking after her neighbors.

Annie passed away on

October 2, 2000 at the Pioneer Memorial Nursing Home in Viborg. She had attained the age of 95.

She was preceded in death by her husband, parents, eight siblings and one daughter-in-law, Adeline.
