Johanna Paulsen Boyer died in Midland, Texas on January 11, 2006. She was buried at Trinity Memorial Park, Big Spring, Texas, alongside her husband, George Boyer.

Johanna Marie Paulsen was born in Viborg, South Dakota on July 14, 1915 to Anders and Mariane Eilersen Paulsen. She received her elementary and secondary education in Turner

County. She attended Yankton College and later received her B. A. degree from St. Mary's College of Maryland.

Johanna taught school in South Dakota until World War II when she entered Civil Service with the U. S. Navy.

On June 15, 1951, she was married to George F. Boyer of Ashton, S. D. In the following years she taught in Puerto Rico and Maryland. Her husband, George Boyer, died in 1987 in Big Spring, Texas.

On March 25, 1991 she was married to Richard DeLamarter of Roswell, New Mexico, who died in 1998.

She is survived by her son Michael Boyer of Denver, Colorado, and two daughters - Mariane Merworth of Midland, Texas and Margo Bazley of Oceanside, California. She is also survived by nine grandchildren and ten great-grandchildren.
