Funeral services for Carl M. Hansen are being held today (Thursday) at the Bethany Lutheran Church at 2 p.m. with Rev. K. R. Jensen officiating. Interment will be at Bethany cemetery west of town. The Viborg Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements.

Carl Marinus Hansen, born in the village of Swan Lake August 8th, 1888, died at the Veterans' Hospital, Sioux Falls, July 9th, 1956. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith. He grew to manhood in the Spring Valley community. He was a veteran of the first world war.

He leaves to mourn his passing, a twin brother, Otto, who lives northwest of Viborg, another brother, Nels, of South Shore, S.
