Louis Jensen was born in Norsundy, Denmark on November 6, 1904. He came to the United States in August of 1924, he worked on various farms in this area until he married Martina Andersen on November 10, 1928. To this union one son, Kermit was born on October 22, 1930, then in 1933 they moved into Viborg, where they continued to make their home until Louis passed away on July 25, 1983.

Louis was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith in Denmark. He was a member of Our Savior's Lutheran Church.

During war time he helped build the Air Base at Sioux Falls, later he owned and operated Hansen's Cafe and other cafes here in Viborg. He also operated a radio and television repair for many years. He also worked for the Human Services Center at Yankton, South Dakota for 9 years.

Louis was also active in the Senior Citizens of Viborg.

He was preceded in death by his parents in Denmark.

He is survived by his wife Martina, and son Kermit and daughter-in-law, Geraldine of Minneapolis, Minnesota; two grandsons, Roger of St. Louis Park, Minnesota and Bradley of Minneapolis; three great grandchildren, Martina, Bradley and Garrett, and one sister Victoria Miller of Norsundy, Denmark.
