FUNERAL SERVICES HELD FEB. 23rd FOR HARRY CHRISTENSEN

Funeral services for Harry Christensen were held from the Bethany Lutheran Church in Viborg on Wednesday, Feb. 23, 1972, with Rev. Noel Vold officiating. Organist was Mrs. Helen Holm and soloist was Mrs. Keith Sorenson. Pallbearers were: Roy Christensen, Glenn Christensen, Tosten Williamson, Curtis Kelly, Allen Morrison, and Gerald Morrison. Interment was in Spring Valley Lutheran Cemetery.

Harry Christensen was born in Turner County, South Dakota, on November 28, 1891, to Anders and Andrea Christensen, and passed away Feb. 20, 1972, at the age of 80 years, 2 months and 22 days.

He was baptized in the Lutheran faith. He was a veteran of World War I, and on June 25, 1919, was united in marriage to Sena Jensen. To this union was born four children, two of whom died in infancy.

They farmed in Turner County until 1936 when they moved to Viborg, S. Dak., where he was employed until he retired in 1957. His health failed him one year ago, and he passed away at Mom & Dad's Nursing Home in Sioux Falls.

Preceding him in death were his two sons, his parents, five brothers, and one sister.

He leaves to mourn his passing, his wife; one son, Edward of Yankton; one daughter, Erma—Mrs. Richard Spomer of Viborg; seven grandchildren; one great-grandson; one foster son, Roger Nelson of Seattle, Wash.; four sisters, Mrs. Alice Berthelsen, Mrs. Charlie Jensen, Mrs. Mabel Christensen, all of Viborg, and Mrs. Nels Berthelsen of Parker; one brother, Alfred of Viborg; and a host of relatives and friends.
