Funeral Held For Arnold Frederickson

Arnold Frederickson, 94, of Viborg, died Sunday, January 19, at the Pioneer Memorial Home.

Mr. Frederickson was born November 7, 1897, near Komstad in Clay County. He was educated in country school and at Viborg and Centerville high schools. He attended business school at York, NE. He was employed at the Bank of Viborg and then an Irene bank. He moved to Sioux Falls in 1928 as office manager for Olsen and Frankman Commission Co. and later was a partner.

He married Gina Rickensrude, March 30, 1938, in Canton. She died September 9, 1949.

He later married Marjorie Abel, who died March 19, 1963.

He was a member of First Baptist Church, a member of Oddfellow Lodge for 68 years, Masonic Lodge for 64 years and Sioux Falls Elks for 38 years. He sang with the Minnehaha Mandskor chorus for 56 years. He was president of the Norwegian Singers Association of America for two years and president of the Minnehaha Mandskor for eight years.

In 1986 he moved to Viborg to the resident section of the Pioneer Memorial Hospital and Home.

Survivors include his brother, Raymond, Viborg; a step-daughter, Eleanor Fiegen, Sioux Falls; a stepson, Richard Abel, Hagerstown, MD; seven grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren.

Services will begin at 1:30 p.m., Thursday, at First Baptist Church, with burial in Woodlawn Cemetery. Visitation is at Miller Funeral Home.
