KNUT ALENDAL, PIONEER RESIDENT, PASSED AWAY FOLLOWING ILLNESS

Resided in This Locality More Than 50 Years

Knut Alendal was born at Skjold Norway on April 22, 1863 and he passed away at the Sioux Valley hospital at Sioux Falls on October 22, 1938, at the age of 75 years, 6 months.

In his infancy he was baptized and later confirmed in the Lutheran faith. At the age of 23 in the year of 1886 he came to Centerville, S. D., and the following year he was married to Anna Johannesdatter, who passed away in the year of 1891.

In the year of 1894 he was united in marriage to Elsie Madsen and to this union 11 children were born, 8 of whom are living, namely: Carl, of Miranda, S. D.; Clara (Mrs. Melville Wilson), Eddie, Robert and Hanna, of Rex. Sask., Canada; Arthur, Ida (Mrs. Hadley Nelson), Tillie (Mrs. Raymond Frederickson), of Viborg, S. D. 3 preceded him in death, Ole, who was killed in the World war, and 2 babies who died in infancy. The deceased had been failing in health for the last 3 months, but was able to be up and around until 3 weeks ago.

On October 21 he was taken to the hospital where everything possible was done but to no avail. On Saturday morning, October 22, he passed away.

Funeral services were held at the Hooker Lutheran church on Wednesday, Oct. 26th, with Rev. David Larson officiating.

Two sisters, Mrs. Ole Ostrem, of Centerville, and Mrs. John Snoen of Hooker, preceded him in death.

He leaves to mourn his death his wife; 8 children; 16 grandchildren, and 1 brother, Ole Andal, and a host of relatives and friends.
