OBITUARY

ISAK OLSEN

Isak Olsen was born in Tolne Vendsyell, Denmark, Nov. 13, 1859 and was baptised and confirmed in the Lutheran faith. He immigrated to America at the age of 19 and a few years later took up a homestead in Turner county. In 1888 he married Bodel Petersen and to them were born eleven children, two of whom died in infancy.

In 1912 the Olsens retired from the farm and moved to Viborg where Mrs. Olsen passed on May 15th, 1923.

He married Mrs. Minnie Petersen in July 1924. For several years he had been ailing and gradually became weaker, finally becoming confined to his bed just two weeks before the end came, April 24th at which time he was 72 years, 5 months and 9 days old.

He leaves to mourn him his wife nine children and four step-children: Anna Aggergaard, Tena Sorensen, Eddie and Alvin of Viborg; Helga Kjergaard, Lora Flynn of Irene; Willie Olsen, of Wakonda, Peter Olsen, Sioux Falls, Irena Sorensen, New Castle, Neb., Willard Petersen, California; Dewey Petersen, Irene; Mrs. Victor Johnson, Hurley and Vivian Petersen of Sioux City. Besidesthese there are 21 grandchildren and two sisters, Mrs. Maggie Andersen, Parker and Mrs. Soren Fredericksen of Garden City.

The funeral srvicees were held at the home and the Baptist church, April 27th, with many friends and relatives filling the edifice for the service. The funeral sermon was preached by Rev. W. E. Prewitt and burial made following.

Isaac Olsen was one of Viborg's best citizens. He was respected by all and his passing marks a distinct loss. The Enterprise joins in extending its condolences to those who mourn.
