ARTHUR C. PETERSEN

Funeral services for Arthur C. Petersen, a resident of this community, were held at the Seventh Day Advent Church in Hurley on Friday, Jan. 22nd, with Rev. Elder Adam Rudy officiating. Interment was in the Evergreen Cemetery.

Arthur C. Petersen was born May 15, 1890, in Turner County, South Dakota, and passed away on Sunday, Jan. 17th, 1954, at the age of 63 years, 8 months and 2 days.

Mr. Petersen lived on a farm with his parents near Viborg during his boyhood and youth. At the age of 22 he was united in marriage with Rose Thompson and the couple made their home on a farm near Viborg. He continued farming operations until 1941 when they made their home in the city of Viborg and he retired from farming.

In 1948 his wife, Rose, passed away and he continued living in Viborg until about two years ago, because of failing health, he moved to Stockholm, S. D., and made his home with his brother, Wendell. He suffered from a diabetic condition which became so bad that he went into a coma on Saturday, and passed away on Sunday.

He leaves to mourn five brothers and two sisters, Wendell of Stockholm, Mervin and Jimmie of Centerville, Melvin and Ralph of Viborg, Effie, Mrs. Ernest Christensen of Viborg, and Mayme, Mrs. Harry Thompson of Hurley and many other relatives and a host of friends.
