# Arlo Andersen, Former Viborg Mayor, VFW Post 7025 Leader, Dies Sept. 6

Taught Hunter Safety Course Over 30 years

Funeral services were held for Arlo W. Andersen on Saturday, September 9, 1995 at 2:00 p.m. at the Bethany Lutheran Church in Viborg.

Arlo Wayne Andersen was born October 18, 1925 at Center Point. His parents were Chris M. and Marie (Ernstsen) Andersen.

Arlo went to school at Kaylor and graduated from Viborg High School in 1943. He joined the Marine Corps in 1943 and served in the South Pacific. He married Elaine Andersen on June 1, 1947 at Viborg. They lived in Viborg where he worked for Turner Hutchinson Electric for 43 years. He retired in October, 1989.

Arlo was a member of the VFW and Bethany Lutheran Church in Viborg. He had served on the church council, the town council, and had been the mayor of Viborg.

He started the Hunter Safety Course and had taught it for over 30 years.

He had been a Memorial Day participant for 49 years as Sargent at Arms. He was a ham radio operator and enjoyed hunting, fishing, and spending time in the Black Hills.

Arlo passed away Wednesday, September 6, 1995 at the Pioneer Memorial Hospital. He had attained the age of 69.

He was preceded in death by his parents, 1 brother Glenn, and 2 infant sisters.

Arlo is survived by his wife Elaine of Viborg, 2 sons Kurt and wife Kathy and Glen and wife Roberta of Sioux Falls; 1 daughter Stephanie and husband Mark Turgeon of Lennox; 5 grandchildren Jacob, Stefan, and Jessie Limmer, Erik Andersen, and Christina Andersen; and other relatives and friends.
