Funeral Services Held On Monday For Bert Pinney

Funeral services for Bert Pinney were held on Monday, April 17th, from the Viborg Methodist Church with Rev. Emil Muhlhausen officiating. Mrs. Robert Ward was the soloist and Charlotte Peterson was organist. Pallbearers were Paul Varnum, Eskild Lund, Burns Coleman, Albert Daniels, Leo N. Christensen, and Burdell Christensen. Burial was in Rosehill Cemetery.

Bert Harris Pinney, son of Robert and Carrie Pinney, was born September 14, 1888, at Viborg, S. Dak., and passed away suddenly in an automobile accident near Davis, S. D., on April 14, 1967, at the age of 78 years and 7 months.

He was born and raised on a local farm and later served in the Armed Forces during World War I.

In August, 1918, he was united in marriage to Alma E. Larson. To this union were born two children, Gerald and Shirley.

In the 1930's and 40's he served as the Viborg City Marshall for 17 years. In December, 1942, he married Sylva A. Iverson of Viborg, S. D. In May, 1966, he married Dacy L. Perry. He was a member of the Royal Arch Masons and of the American Legion. He was a resident at the Sunset Manor Home in Irene, S. Dak., at the time of his death.

He was preceded in death by his parents, two sisters, and one brother.

He is survived by his son, Gerald F. Pinney, St. Louis, Missouri; his daughter, Shirley (Mrs. Ben Bradshaw), North Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada; a sister, Blanche (Mrs. Olie Skonhovd) of Viborg, S. Dak.; three granddaughters, and other relatives and friends who mourn his passing.
