Ingrid Petersen, 91, died March 12, 2013 at Pioneer Memorial Nursing Home in Viborg.

Ingrid Petersen was born February 16, 1922 at Deerfield in the Black Hills. Her parents were Norwegian immigrants Ingvald and Anne (Bjermeland) Knutson. At the age of 3, her mother died and her father brought her and 3 sisters to Viborg. They were put into 4 different homes and Ingrid went to the Louie Levison home. She married Leslie R. Petersen and they were married for 50 years before his death in 1988. Ingrid and Leslie owned and operated the L & I Clothing Store for 28 years. She was very active in her church, being on the board of Deacon Trustee, church treasurer, ABW President, and youth leader. She was a member of Turner, Opal and Vermillion Rebekah Lodges serving as Noble Grand and over 20 years as treasurer and a member for 68 years. She was a member of the Viborg Danish Dancers and was president of the Viborg History Book covering families 1893 to 1993, from Denmark to Dakota.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, 3 sisters Aletta, Clara and Anne Knutson, foster brother Lloyd Levison and foster sisters Pearl Levison Auten and Lola Levison.

Ingrid is survived by her daughter Barbara Faye and husband Dale E. Nelson of Nixa, MO; and other relatives and friends.
