FUNERAL SERVICES HELD THURSDAY FOR MARTIN MILLER

Funeral services for Martin Miller were held from Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Viborg on Thursday, May 2, 1974. Pastor Love officiated at the service. Organist was Mrs. Oliver Anderson, and soloist was Mrs. Kermit Holm, who sang "Softly and Tenderly", and "Lord I'm Coming Home". Honorary pallbearers were Otto Paulsen, Wm. Lodde, Andrew Hansen, John Jespergaard, Wm. Schilling, and Ervin Jorgensen. Pallbearers were grandsons—Robert Martin Miller, Jr., Randal Mark Miller, Robert Bruneau, David Bruneau, Charles Bertrand, and Dean Peterson. Ole Alendal Post No. 117 was in charge of the military honors at the graveside. Interment was in Rosehill Cemetery.

A prayer service was held Tuesday, May 1, at the Fraternal Funeral Home in Viborg.

Martin Miller was born in Denmark on May 31, 1892. He passed away in his home on April 28, 1974, at the age of 81 years, 10 months and 28 days.

He came to the United States and to Hurley S. D., in 1913. He married Ida Peterson Nov. 5, 1925, at Hurley. The couple farmed near Viborg until Mrs. Miller died Feb. 1, 1966. Mr. Miller retired and moved to Viborg in 1966. He was a veteran of Army service in France during World War I. Mr. Miller was a member of American Legion Post No. 117, the Danish Brotherhood Society, and Our Savior's Lutheran Church.

Survivors include a son, Robert of Viborg; two daughters, Mrs. Mary Bruneau of Jefferson, S. D., and Mrs. Ann Peterson, Centerville; 11 grandchildren, and 4 great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his wife, his parents, four brothers, and four sisters.
