BURIED WEDNESDAY

Funeral Services Held at Danish Lutheran Church

Funeral services for Carl Knutson this (Wednesday) afternoon, as we are going to press, at the Danish Evangelical Lutheran church with Rev. C. C. Rasmussen officiating.

The tragic ending of young Carl's life occurred a mile east of Irene on the night of Memorial Day about 8 p. m., when his car went out of control and he was pinned beneath it. The body was taken to Irene and examined by Dr. L. F. Beall and a verdict of accidental death returned by the coroner.

Carl better known as "Cody" has been employed at the Anderson Motor Co. for some time, but recently secured a job at Irene. He is survived by a wife in Milwaukee and is the youngest son of Mr. and Mrs. Erick Knutson.

Carl Einar Knutson was born at Viborg, S. D., August 10, 1905. He was baptized in the Lutheran faith on October 22 of the same year and confirmed April 3, 1921.

He was united in marriage on August 14, 1925 to Lillian Lutterman. No children were born to this union.

Through out the greater part of his life his home has been in this community and the news of his sudden passing in an automobile accident on the night of Saturday, May 30, was a distinct shock to the community.

He leaves to mourn his untimely death, his wife, Mrs. Lillian Knutson; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Erick Knutson; three sisters, and two brothers, namely; Agnes, Mrs. Chris Madsen of Underwood, S. D.; Else, Mrs. Irving Larsen of Adams, Nebr.; Knud, Eleonora, Mrs. Ike Fredricksen and Walter all of Viborg. An infant sister has preceded him in death.

Besides these a large number of friends grieve at the untimely passing of a goodhearted and likeable comrade.
