JUST H. PETERSON

Funeral services for Just H. Peterson were held on Wednesday, Feb. 24, from the Hansen Funeral Home at 1:30 p.m., and at Turkey Valley Lutheran Church at 2:00 p.m. Pastor H. S. Madsen officiated. The song, "My Heart, O Holy Spirit", was sung at the home, and "Jesus, Savior, Pilot Me", "I'm A Pilgrim", and "Now We Must Bid One Another Farewell", were sung at the church by the choir. Just H. Peterson, 65, was seized with a sudden illness and died shortly thereafter, on Saturday, Feb. 20, at his farm home near Irene while shoveling snow. He had otherwise been feeling quite well of late.
