FUNERAL SERVICE HELD TUESDAY FOR MRS. H. PETERSON

**Former Viborg Girl Passed
Away at Beresford—
Age 22**

**HAZEL CARNES
BEFORE MARRIAGE**

**Married in October, 1925 to
Hans Peterson of
Beresford**

Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon at the Methodist Episcopal church for Mrs. Hans Peterson 22 years old, who died shortly after noon Saturday following an emergency operation a few hours earlier. Rev. F. W. Cannon and Rev. A. V. Neve officiated at the funeral and burial was made in St. Peters cemetery.

Ten days before her death, Mrs. Peterson became the mother of a baby boy who lived little more than a day. Complications set in following this but her condition had shown a steady improvement until Friday afternoon when she took a sudden turn for the worse. A specialist from Sioux City was called for consultation with the attending physician and it was decided that the only chance of saving her life was through an operation. She was taken to the Beresford General hospital at 1 o'clock Saturday morning and operated on. She rallied from the operation, but at 12:30 P. M. lapsed into unconsciousness and died a half hour later.

Mrs. Peterson, who was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Adren Carnes was born at Lennox, December 28, 1904. Seven years ago she moved with her parents to Beresford, where she completed her grade school education and had two year high school work.

On October 7, 1925, she was united in marriage to Hans P. Peterson and lived on a farm 12 miles northwest of Beresford.

Besides her husband and parents she is survived by two sisters, Mrs. W. H. Scroggs of Wakonda and Miss Viola Carnes of Beresford and two brothers, Loyal and Miles, both of whom live here.—Beresford Republic.

Mrs. Peterson was before her marriage Miss Hazel Carnes, and was well known to a large number of our people as she lived here with her parents before moving to Beresford.
