FUNERAL SERVICES HELD WEDNESDAY KNUD N. KNUDSEN

Funeral services were held from Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Viborg on Wednesday, Feb. 11, for Knud N. Knudsen, 72, who passed away on Feb. 7 at Pioneer Memorial Hospital. Rev. Paul Petersen officiated. Mrs. L. J. Rasmussen was the organist, and soloist was Mrs. Robert Knudsen who sang "How Great Thou Art" and "The Old Rugged Cross".
