FUNERAL SERVICES HELD TUESDAY FOR JOHANNA REINHOLDT

Funeral services for Mrs. Johanna Reinholdt, 93, were held on Tuesday, July 23, from the Bethany Lutheran Church, Viborg. Pastor Noel Vold officiated. Mrs. Helen Holm was the organist, and soloist was Mrs. Delano Christensen. Pallbearers were Glen Reinholdt, Arlen Bendert, Donald Hartwell, Willie Reinholt, Howard Reinholt, and Richard Reinholt. Burial was in Bethania Cemetery.

Johanne Mathilda Reinholdt was born April 19, 1875, in Denmark, the daughter of Thomas Christian Christensen and Kristina Katrine Christensen. At the age of 8 she came with her parents to the United States, settling in South Dakota where she lived the rest of her life.

On September 24, 1892, she was united in marriage to Peter John Reinholdt at Yankton, South Dakota. They settled on a farm near Irene where they lived until her husband's death in 1931. The following year she moved to Viborg. Three years ago she entered the Good Samaritan Home in Centerville, South Dakota.

She passed away Friday, July 19th, after a short illness, at the Pioneer Memorial Hospital in Viborg, South Dakota. She was 93 years of age.

She leaves to mourn, three daughters, Mrs. Katherine Hartwell of Denver, Colo., Esther (Mrs. Arlo Bendert) of Rapid City, S. Dak., and Florence (Mrs. Kenneth Graham) of Clovis, Calif.; four sons, Marius of Irene, S. Dak., Willie of Sioux Falls, S. Dak., Howard of Costa Mesa, Calif., and Charlie of California; also 19 grandchildren; 28 great-grandchildren; three sisters, Mrs. Lizzie Peterson of Portland, Ore., Mrs. Emma Olson of Portland, Ore., and Mrs. Margarite Moore of Detroit, Mich., and one brother, Ernest Christensen of Yankton, South Dakota, and other relatives and friends.

Preceding her in death, besides her husband, were two daughters, Nora (Mrs. Ernest Petersen) and Anne (Mrs. Charles Osterlok), and one son, John.
