Chloe Potts was born at Amstrerdam, Holland, October 13, 1862. Her parents immigrated to America when she was but two years old, settling at Rochester, N. Y. From there they moved to Orange City, Iowa, in 1874, and later, in 1876 to Dakota territory onto a homestead near Swan Lake.

On May 3, 1880 she was united in marriage to Albert N. Apland. To this union were born nine children; Nels, Mattie, Mabel, Minnie, Lillian, Ralph, Bertha, John and Charley. Of these Mattie died in infancy, Minnie at the age of twelve years and Ralph at the age of twenty-six years. Through out her life she was a devoted mother and an ideal home maker.

The family resided on the homestead near Hooker until 1907, when they moved to Viborg, S. D. While she retained her membership in the church and maintained her religious interests, her health at this time forced her to give up active work. In 1910 the family moved to Canistota, S. D., where she spent the remainder of her life. She passed away Tuesday, May 17, 1927, at the age of 64 years, 7 months and 4 days.

She leaves to mourn her loss, the husband, six children and seven grand children; two sisters, Mrs. R. O. Pinney, Viborg, S. D.; Mrs. Charles Leavers, Canadagwa, N. Y., and one brother, Gerrett Pott of Seattle, Washington.

The children were all present when she passed in the peace of God to her Pilot's call.

Funeral services were held at the home Thursday, May 19, 1927, at 2:00 o'clock and at 2:30 at the M. E. church, in charge of Rev. Stimpke.
