Mrs. Dorothy Lloyd Among Nine Killed In Rapid City Plane Crash

Funeral services for Mrs. Dorothy Lloyd are being held Thursday (today) at Rapid City. Mrs. Lloyd, daughter of Mrs. Ida Goodhope of Viborg, was killed Sunday in the airplane crash at Rapid City which took the lives of six high school girl cheerleaders and three adults. The aircraft, a Beechcraft BE 18, was returning from Sioux Falls where the state's Class A high school basketball tournament concluded Saturday night. Mrs. Lloyd, 60, was an English teacher and faculty advisor to the cheerleaders accompanying them on the trip. The plane was landing in a crosswind of 20 mph with gusts to 25 mph and had nearly touched down when it rose into the air, cartwheeled on a wing and came to a stop 100 yds. off the runway. Apparently the plane flipped in the wind. A fire broke out and all nine aboard perished in the plane, including the pilot of the plane, Ivan Landstrom, and his wife, Mrs. Landstrom. Their daughter, Shirley Landstrom, was also one of the six cheerleaders killed.
